

Field Service Chemist

Main Job Function

This full-time position exists to ensure the safe pick-up and transport of all waste to and from the facility by communicating with customers, completing manifests, sorting and packing waste, securing waste on the truck, and safely driving it back to DLD.

This is not an office/lab position—it requires a Class B CDL with Hazardous Materials endorsement. **All CDL training will be provided and paid for by DLD.** Applicants must meet requirements to obtain CDL and Hazardous Materials endorsement.

Major Responsibilities & Duties

- Provide excellent customer service
- Sort and identify waste according to hazard class
- Package, label and manifest waste
- Correctly load containers of waste for transport
- Drive truck back to facility

Qualifications

- Strong interpersonal and communication skills
- Ability to safely load waste containers (as much as 55-gallon drums of liquid) onto a truck
- Legible handwriting
- Ability to work in extreme temperatures (both hot and cold)
- Must comply with all safety and work rules and regulations
- Able to occasionally stay overnight when traveling
- Must be 21 years of age or older

Education and Experience

- Bachelor's Degree in Chemistry or other natural science field or equivalent experience
- The ability to acquire a Class B Commercial Drivers License with Hazardous Material endorsement
- Experience in commingling and/or segregating waste chemicals helpful, but not required
